Family Cycle Ride

You are invited to join us on Sunday 8th July, Cycling to the West of Reading in Two Valleys

We will be cycling on tow paths, cycle tracks, bridle ways and minor roads following the paths of the Kennet & Avon Canal and River Thames in the rural areas to the west of Reading.

Although this event is intended as a gentle family ride for scouts and their parents, accompanying parents are not essential but would be encouraged. The majority of the 20 mile route is generally flat, some of the route is rough and undulating so road racing bikes or BMX's are not recommended!

You will be responsible for getting bikes to and from The Waterside Activity Centre at the north end of the A329 (M) by 9.45am and we plan to leave at 10am returning at by approximately 5pm.

It is hoped that there will be sufficient time for plenty of stops for coffee, tea, ice creams etc. and a visit to a local attraction. A packed lunch and water will be required.

A support vehicle will be attending to assist if required, any punctures will hopefully be repaired FOC however replacement inner tubes etc will be chargeable.

The cost for the day is a minimal £2 per person to a max of £5 per family to cover fuel of the support vehicle however we hope to receive a guided tour of Mapledurum Mill for an additional entry cost of approximately £4 per head
